0:00:58.579,0:01:01.789 Let's say that I'm interested in this post here.

0:01:01.789,0:01:08.360 If I click on it, it'll show the post, but it'll also give me an opportunity to comment

0:01:28.860,0:01:32.160 But I'm going to switch it back to upvote.

0:01:34.430,0:01:40.390 And the score for each comment is listed beside the user's name.

0:01:43.030,0:01:45.700 Up for upvote, down for downvote. 0:01:45.700,0:01:53.880 And it'll show you the overall score in between the two votes.

0:01:53.880,0:02:00.000 If I wanted to go to this subreddit in particular, I can click r/aww for Reddit Aww.

0:02:00.000,0:02:03.710 And it'll show me only posts from that subreddit.

0:02:03.710,0:02:09.289 If I didn't like this content, I could unsubscribe by clicking this button over here.

0:02:09.289,0:02:13.650 Or I could click this button to create my own post.

0:02:13.650,0:02:16.989 Many subreddits offer you three different options for how to post.

0:02:16.989,0:02:22.300 You can post a text post here, an image or video in the center, or a link to a different

0:02:23.560,0:02:27.709 If you'll notice, on Reddit Aww, text posts are disabled.

0:02:36.180,0:02:41.340 All of the subreddits that I'm subscribed to are in this drop down menu.

0:02:41.340,0:02:45.810 As you can see here, I subscribed to the 10 that I recommended for you.

0:02:45.810,0:02:51.109 If I were to click on any of these, it would take me to that specific subreddit.

0:02:51.109,0:02:58.170 And I could find out more information there.

0:02:58.170,0:03:03.329 For example, if I clicked on r/aww, we go back to r/aww.

0:03:03.329,0:03:09.079 Many subreddits have related subreddits on the right-hand side menu below the rules.

0:03:14.069,0:03:19.749 R/aww is about cute animals and babies and so forth.

0:03:19.749,0:03:25.510 So if you really liked the content here, you might also like some of these subreddits over

0:03:26.510,0:03:28.950 For example, Dog Pictures.

0:03:28.950,0:03:36.560 If I clicked on that, I'd get only dog pictures.

0:03:36.560,0:03:41.749 If I subscribe to this subreddit by clicking that button, now Dog Pictures will show up

0:03:41.749,0:03:43.430 in my subscriptions.

0:03:43.430,0:03:55.189 And if I go back to the home page for Reddit, I should find some dog pictures in my feed. 0:03:55.189,0:03:58.749 There's one right there!
